

36th WORKSOP HALF MARATHON – Sunday, 29th OCTOBER, 2017

Notification of forthcoming event and road closures.



Dear Resident,

The 36th running of the Worksop Half Marathon will take place on Sunday, 29th October. Over 2,600 runners are expected, making this Worksop's largest participation sporting event. We hope that you will support this event, as it passes close to your home, and that you will enjoy watching such an inspiring spectacle! Perhaps you, or members of your family or friends, would even like to take part in the 3km fun run, which you can enter on the day or by visiting our web site.

The Half Marathon race will start at 10.00am at the **Outwood Portland Academy**. The course will follow the same route as last year, starting at the Outwood Portland Academy & heading up Sparken Hill & along the B6034 as far as the Carburton crossroads. It will then pass through Clumber Park, where it will exit at Truman's Lodge. The route then turns right along the Old Coach Road to Manton Lodge, before turning left on to Windmill Lane. The runners will then pass through the grounds of Worksop College before returning to the Outwood Portland Academy on Sparken Hill.

The following roads will be closed to through traffic: Sparken Hill (close to Outwood Portland Academy) & the B6034, from the Netherton Road roundabout to the Carburton Crossroads, from 07:30 to 15:00. The Police will, however, minimize the inconvenience to residents, by allowing access to and from properties, at every safe opportunity, between groups of runners.

Alternative diversion routes will be clearly sign posted to ensure minimum disruption. Please try & plan your journeys accordingly.
